## AWARD WINNING SHORT FILM "HUNGRY" TO SCREEN AS PART OF THE 4<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL UTOPIA FILM FESTIVAL

Almost thirteen years to the day after he took his first acting and improv classes at the newly formed The Ensemble School in Frederick, Maryland, Trent, writer and director of "Hungry," will present his latest award winning short film as part of the Shorts Program at the 4th Annual Utopia Film Festival in Greenbelt, Maryland ([www.utopiafilmfestival.org](http://www.utopiafilmfestival.org)).

Trent is currently a film student at Los Angeles City College, where notable alumni include Clint Eastwood and Morgan Freeman. His next goal is to transfer to the world-renowned USC School of Cinematic Arts in the fall of 2009 to pursue his Bachelor and Master Degrees in Film Production.

Before moving to Los Angeles, CA in 2004, he spent three years acting and studying in Chicago, IL at such places as The Second City, ImprovOlympic, and The Annoyance Theater. Prior to Chicago, he lived in Frederick, MD and was not only one of the first students of The Ensemble School, that started on October 2, 1995, but he is also a founding ensemble member of Maryland Ensemble Theatre, and is a former member and producer of The Comedy Pigs. He also studied at The Shakespeare Theatre in Washington, D.C.

Trent has dreamed of coming back to Maryland to make his old friends and teachers proud, and the screening of "Hungry," his black and white silent homage to Charlie Chaplin, will certainly accomplish that goal.

"Hungry" will screen as part of the 90 minute Shorts Program at the 4th Annual Utopia Film Festival in Greenbelt, MD on October 25 at 3:30pm at the Greenbelt Community Center (15 Crescent Rd, Greenbelt, MD 20770). Trent will also take part in a director Q & A session after the screening.
